Risk Assessment Guide

Introduction

The information provided in this Risk Assessment Guide is to support you with planning your group's upcoming visit to QUT Galleries and Museums.

Teachers should make themselves aware of the hazards associated with traffic, crossing roads and alighting from or boarding transport when visiting. Please be mindful of exposure to weather conditions if spending time outdoors at QUT Gardens Point, ensuring sun safe measures and active supervision of students at all times.

It is the responsibility of those bringing the group to be aware of any medical or behaviour issues of those in their care, and maintenance of safe and appropriate behaviour for their group during their visit to QUT Galleries and Museums.

Your safety is important to us. As part of QUT's commitment to our community's health and safety we are monitoring the COVID-19 situation closely and following all the relevant advice from government agencies and global organisations.

Accessibility and Supervision

Teachers and accompanying adults are responsible for ongoing supervision of students at all times.

Students are expected to have a responsible attitude and to show respect for the buildings, their contents, the artwork, our staff and other visitors. Please ensure care is taken when moving around the galleries and museums. Do not touch artworks. Keep movement to a walking pace. Please leave all food and drink in the cloakroom, and if sketching please only use pencil. Photography is allowed, without the use of flash, tripods and selfie sticks, except for some special exhibitions as signed. Please share your experience at QUT Galleries and Museums on our social media platforms.

Appropriate numbers of supervisors should accompany each group and always ensure active supervision of students.

The minimum required adult to student ratio is as follows:

Pre-prep and Prep 1:8

Primary School 1:12

Secondary School 1:15

All public access areas of QUT Galleries and Museums are wheelchair accessible. Wheelchairs are also available on request. Accessible toilets are located at Old Government House and at QUT Art Museum.

First Aid

QUT Galleries and Museums has trained First Aid staff who are always available to treat visitors and staff as required. First aid kits are located at Old Government House foyer reception and at the Art Museum front desk.

Please inform staff should a first aid situation arise during your visit. In the unlikely event of an emergency or severe medical issue QUT Galleries and Museums will contact the Queensland Ambulance Service for assessment and patient transfer where appropriate.

Fire Safety and Emergency Evacuation

In the case of an emergency a QUT Galleries and Museums staff member will advise and direct all visitors on appropriate action. Emergency alert and evacuation tones systems are in place at QUT. The QUT Galleries and Museums staff member will provide direction to the supervisor in charge of the group and this person is responsible for ensuring compliance with the directions by all students. Lifts should not be used in a fire emergency.
